Belton shall exercise due diligence in accordance with the OECD conflict mineral guidance. Belton will comply with the requirements related to conflict minerals along our supply chain, and, the responsibly sourcing of minerals.

Belton disapproves of violence, unsafe working conditions, labor, and, be responsible to society and respect human rights, including but not limited to, tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), gold (Au) cobalt, etc, are not from the mines of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), and other conflict-affected or high-risk areas controlled by armed groups.

Belton also expects suppliers to comply with the OECD guidance too.
